Our Quality team at Wentworth-Douglass Hospital has an opportunity for a Quality Improvement (QI) Coordinator. The successful candidate will have a strong focus on quality, safety & service and will:

- Manage and monitor core measure and other quality improvement care processes, to include medical record review and compliance documentation via Midas for CMS and JCAHO purposes.
- Apply core measure criteria to assess and document the appropriateness of care as outlined by the standards. Collaborates with the healthcare team to ensure criteria are met.
- Collect and analyze Core Measurement and other quality improvement reports/ data;
- Collaborate with healthcare teams (and departments) to facilitate improvement of care;
- Assist with development and promotion of (core measure-delete) educational material; leads cross-functional teams to facilitate the improvement of care processes and incorporate best practices.
- Review core measurement admissions daily and assure best clinical practice guidelines are being used, in conjunction with Physician and Nursing care (or work with staff to document the reason(s) for exclusion).
- Coordinate and Facilitate Reliability Core Measurement Meetings, share findings with appropriate staff and department chairs.
- Coordinates medical staff focus reviews and other Peer Review functions, including notification of practitioners, supporting department chairs, completing case reviews, and facilitating Peer Review Committee functions and RCAs.

Requirements:

- BSN and NH RN license
- Strong communication and computer skills
